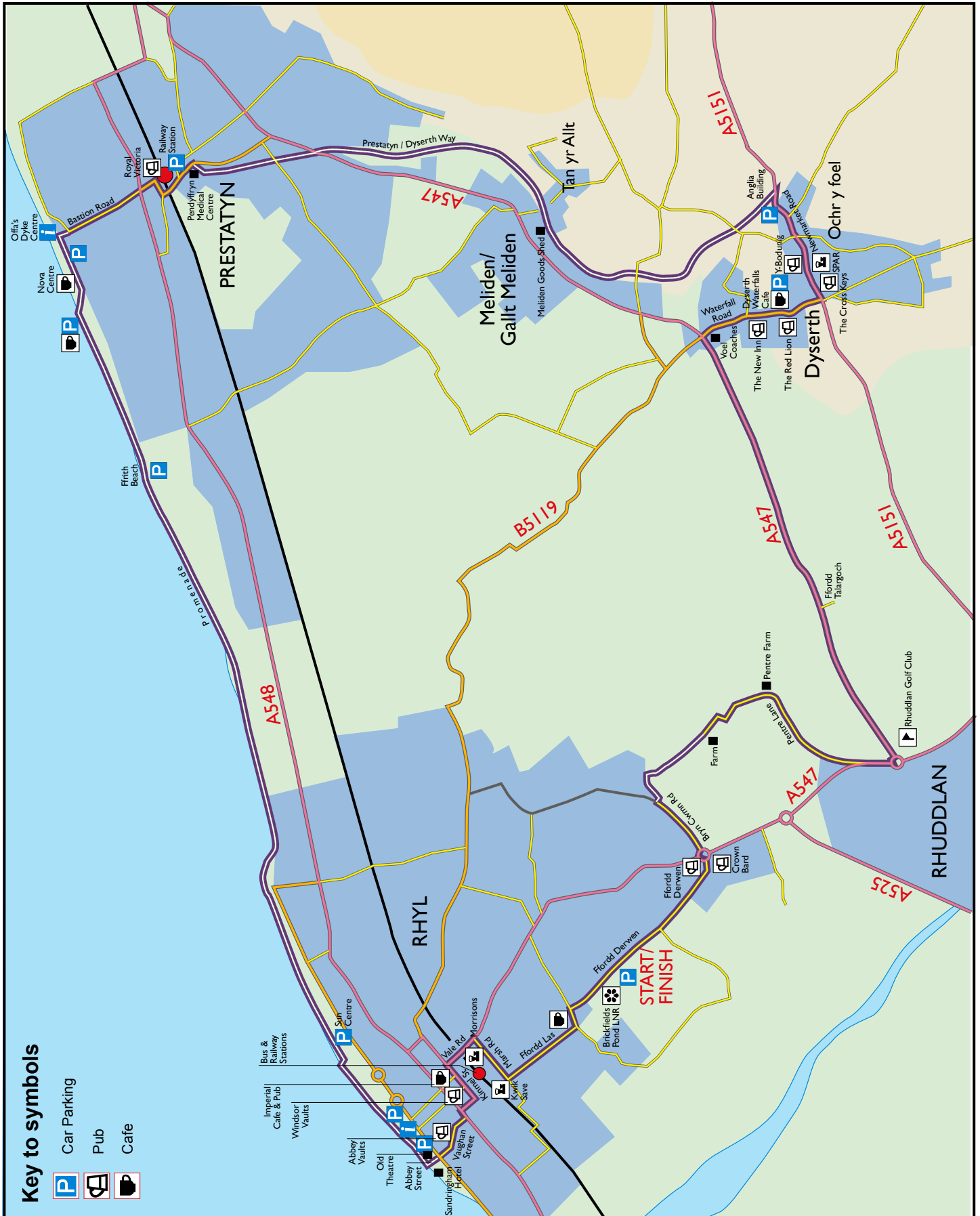

SP	At the Brickfield's Pond Gateway car-park At crossroads turn left	0.3
	Follow road right onto Ffordd Las. You will pass the KJ Ford garage on the left	0.4
	Turn right onto Marsh Road	0.9
	Turn left onto Vale Road. This takes you over the railway bridge	1.3
	Turn left onto Kinmel Street. Passing Bus station on your left	1.5
	Turn right	1.8
	Turn left	1.9
	Turn right onto Vaughan Street	2.0
	Follow road straight onto Abbey Street	2.0
	Cross the main road and make your way past the old theatre to the Promenade where you will meet the cycle track	2.2
	Turn right and follow the cycle track for 6.5km / 4 miles	2.3
	Nova Centre on right	8.5
	Turn right past the Offa's Dyke Centre	8.6
	Follow Road (Bastion Road) to traffic lights	8.7
	At traffic lights, carry straight on	9.2
	Follow road right	9.4
	Follow road left over the railway bridge	9.5
	Turn right onto Banastre Avenue. Pendyffryn Medical Group Surgery is on the corner	9.9
	Turn left onto the Prestatyn-Dyserth Way (through the surgery car-park). This is a 2 2/3 miles long footpath along the route of a disused railway. Continue along the walkway to the Dyserth end	9.9
	Meliden Goods Shed (disused) on right	12.3
	Turn right onto A5151 (Newmarket Road)	14.0
	Turn right down Waterfall Road	14.6
	Turn left onto Ffordd Talagoch	15.4
	Turn right at roundabout towards Rhyl	18.4
	Turn right onto Pentre Lane	18.6
	Turn left onto Bryn Cwnin Road	20.5
	Go straight over the roundabout onto Ffordd Derwen	21.0
